### DeSoto Community Service Hunt

We have a great public relations opportunity! We have been invited by the DeSoto Parks and Recreation Department to help remove metal debris from their Meadow Creek Park Football Complex that was heavily damaged by a tornado.

Date: July 30 Time: 8:00am (or whenever you can get there) Location: 1400 South Uhl Road, DeSoto

The Problem: A large amount of metal and other debris was strewn across the play fields when a tornado destroyed homes near the park. Sharp metal objects were driven in the rain soaked turf, making the fields dangerous and unusable.
