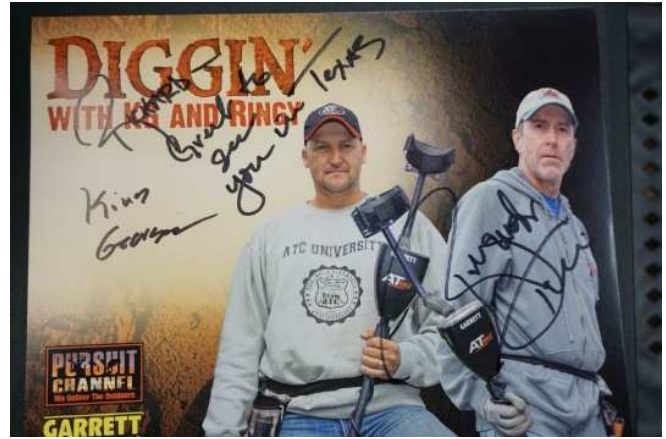
1. Your annual dues must be current at the last meeting before the Hunt.

I will cherish the clock-winding key that I pulled out of the old water well. It was hard to believe that it was the only metal item that the 75-pound magnet pulled out. I found a second coin cache in the two-year span. Not as good or exciting as the first but I'll take it. Of the first cache found in March 2017, I cleaned up two thirds of it and presented it to the landowner in a Riker case. I am working hard on finding closer sites.”
