Club Business: Proposed changes to the By-Laws

Two changes to our club By-Laws were discussed last month. Here is what the By-Laws say about making changes:

Article VIII – Amendments

Section 1. The by-laws may be altered, amended or repealed by two-thirds vote at any regular meeting or meeting called for that purpose provided each member has been given due notice in writing of the proposed change. Notice is customarily given in the regular issue of the Club newsletter.

We are proposing the following changes to be voted on at the August meeting:

Article III – Members, Section 5: (last sentence)

Currently reads: **Annual dues will be due at the September meeting.**

To be replaced by: **Annual dues will be due at the January meeting.**

Article IV – Officers, Section 3

Currently reads: **All officers shall hold office for one year beginning the first regular meeting in January or until their successors have been elected and assume their duties. All officers may be elected for a second term. No officer may hold the same office for more than two (2) consecutive terms.**

To be replaced by: **All officers shall hold office beginning the first regular meeting in January or until their successors have been elected and assume their duties. All officers may be reelected in successive years. There are no term limits.**

Opportunities to serve on Committees:

Members are invited to serve on the club committees. Below is a list of the committees. (Note that some of the original committees listed in the By-Laws have become inactive, and new committees have been added over the years to meet current needs).

- ◆Program Committee (invites speakers)
- ◆Hunt Committee (includes Huntmaster and others who organize club hunts)
- ◆Historian (inactive)
- ◆Hospitality Committee (greet visitors at club meetings)
- ◆Refreshment Committee (Cook, Drinks, set-up at club potluck events)
- ◆Telephone Committee (call reminders monthly to members)

- ◆Community Services (inactive)
- ◆Executive Committee (includes Club officers and Heads of Committees)
- ◆Find of the Month Committee
- ◆Fund Raiser Committee
- ◆Websites Committee (includes Webmaster and Administrators of Facebook Group page)
- ◆Newsletter/Communications Committee (Silver Signal editor)
