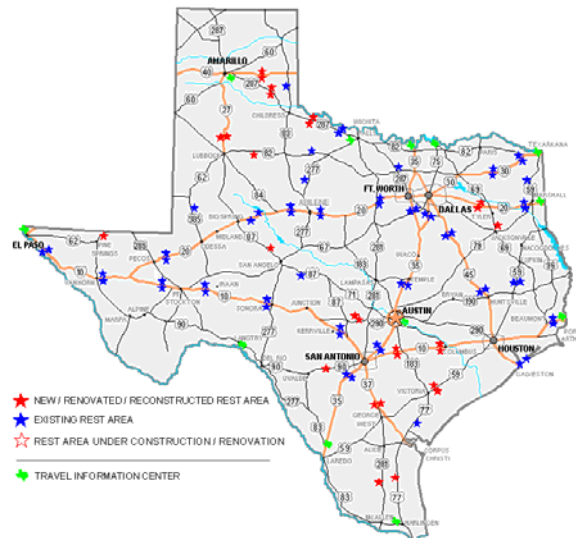
## President's Corner
