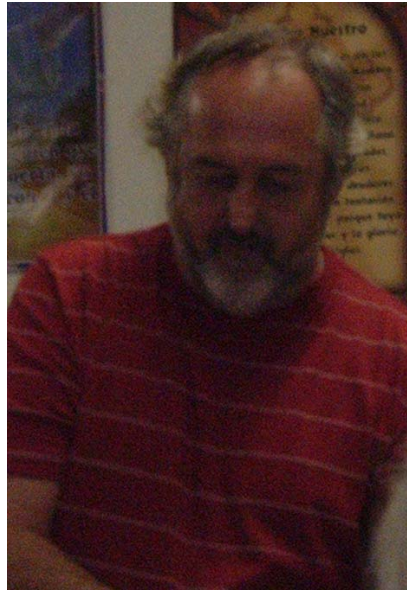
Hope to see you at the meeting. Happy Hunting, and remember to leave the deep ones for me.
